All KMFSC members Basic 4 & above are eligible to contract Club practice ice on a monthly basis. Club ice time may be purchased via the KMFSC Retail Center Website www.KettleMoraineFSC.org. BS or Full membership is required for practice ice.

All KMFSC skaters Snow Plow Sam-Basic 3

The USFSA fee is waived. No payment required until reach Basic 4.

All KMFSC skaters Basic 4-8 and FS 1-6 (Basic Membership)

The annual membership fee must be included with registration. The membership is valid until June 30 of the following year and includes a skating booklet and patches which is delivered to the club.

All KMFSC Testing and Competition Skaters (Full Membership)

The membership fee is for the first family member and a reduced fee for each additional family member. This membership expires June 30 of the following year. The first family member includes a subscription to USFS skating magazine.

KMFSC Membership Volunteer Commitment

Every Basic Skill (BS4-8) and Full KMFSC member is required to volunteer six (6) hours every season outside of the Annual Ice Show participants and Badger State Games participants. Volunteers should be immediate family of each skater and 16 years or older. As you volunteer for an event, your hours will be banked. If **NONE** of your volunteer hours have been fulfilled by end of Session 4 you will be **billed** a **\$100** opt out fee due prior to the next Session registration or annual membership renewal. Skater's who have passed out of FS 6 the opt out fee will be due **PRIOR** to membership renewal on June 30 of the current season.

Failure to pay this fee will result in forfeiture of participation in all KMFSC events such as Leant-To-Skate and Practice Ice.

If your record reflect Volunteer hours or fee due from previous season(s) the fees must be paid in full before your skater will be permitted to participate in KMFSC events. Hours are not transferable season to season or family to family
